Forests Act 1958, No. 6254.

DECLARATION OF PROHIBITED PERIOD.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred by section 3 of the *Forests Act 1958*, I, Edward Raymond Meagher, Her Majesty's Minister of Forests in the State of Victoria, hereby declare the period commencing at Midnight between the first and second days of November, 1967, and ending at Midnight between the thirtieth day of April and the first day of May, 1968, to be a prohibited period in respect to any fire-protected area (other than a State Forest or National Park) situated in the municipalities specified in the Schedule hereto:—
