Country Fire Authority Act 1958.

SUMMER PERIOD IN RESPECT OF SPECIFIED PARTS OF THE COUNTRY AREA OF VICTORIA.

WHEREAS by section 4 of the *Country Fire Authority Act 1958*, it is enacted that the Chief Secretary of Victoria, after consultation with the Minister of Forests, may from time to time by declaration published in the *Government Gazette* declare any period to be the summer period in respect of the country area of Victoria, or any specified part or parts thereof and, without affecting the generality of the foregoing, may declare different periods to be the summer period in respect of different parts of the said country area:

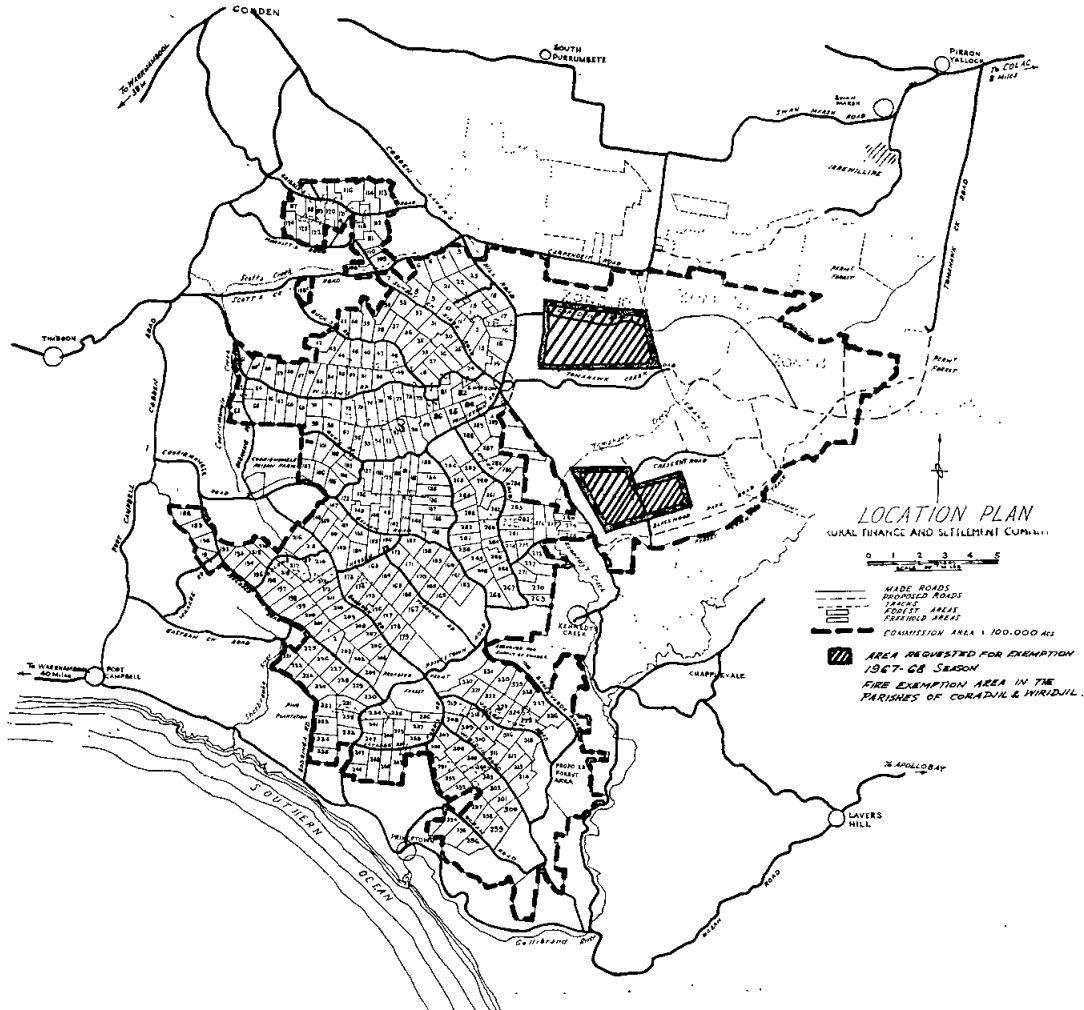
And whereas the Chief Secretary and the Minister of Forests have consulted accordingly:

Now therefore I, the Chief Secretary of Victoria, do hereby declare the period commencing at midnight on the 17th November, 1967, and ending at midnight on the 30th April, 1968, to be the summer period in respect of the parts of the country area of Victoria specified in the Schedule hereto: and being the First, Third, Seventh, Ninth, Twelfth, Fourteenth, Fifteenth, Sixteenth, Seventeenth, Nineteenth, Twenty-third, Twenty-fourth and

Twenty-sixth and portions of the Sixth, Eighth, Eleventh, Twentieth, Twenty-first and Twenty-second Fire Control Regions.

SCHEDULE (No. 4).

- The First Fire Control Region comprising the municipal districts of the City of Ballarat, the Borough of Sebastopol and those portions of the Shires of Ballarat, Bungaree, Buninyong and Grenville not included in the Fifteenth Fire Control Region;
- the Third Fire Control Region comprising the municipal districts of the Cities of Geelong, Geelong West and Newtown and Chilwell and those portions of the Shires of Barrabool, Bellarine, Corio and South Barwon not included in the Seventh Fire Control Region;
- the Sixth Fire Control Region comprising the municipal districts of the City of Colac, the Town of Camperdown and the Shires of Colac, Hampden, Heytesbury and Otway; except those portions of the Sixth Fire Control Region comprising land under the control of the Rural Finance and Settlement Commission which the Governor in Council has consented to be used for settlement under the *Land Settlement Act 1959*, and being the land situated in the Parishes of Coradjil and Wiridjil, shown by hachure on the plan hereunder.



- the Seventh Fire Control Region comprising the municipal districts of the Borough of Queenscliffe, the Shires of Bannockburn, Leigh and Winchelsea and those portions of the Shires of Barrabool, Bellarine, Corio and South Barwon not included in the Third Fire Control Region;
- the Ninth Fire Control Region comprising the municipal districts of the City of Moe, the Shires of Buln Buln, Korumburra, Mirboo, Narracan, South Gippsland, Warragul and Woorayl and the Yallourn Works Area, pursuant to the *State Electricity Commission Act 1958*;
- the Twelfth Fire Control Region comprising the municipal districts of the Shires of Alexandra, Broadford, Kilmore, McIvor, Pyalong, Seymour and Yea;
- the Fourteenth Fire Control Region comprising the municipal districts of the Shires of Bacchus Marsh, Gisborne, Melton, Newham and Woodend and Romsey and those portions of the Cities of Broadmeadows, Keilor and Sunshine and the Shires of Bulla, Diamond Valley, Werribee and Whittlesea not included in the Metropolitan Fire District;
- the Fifteenth Fire Control Region comprising the municipal districts of the City of Maryborough and the Shires of Ballan, Creswick, Daylesford and Glenlyon, Kyneton, Newstead, Talbot and Clunes and Tullaroop and those portions of the Shires of Ballarat, Bungaree, Buninyong and Grenville not included in the First Fire Control Region;
- the Sixteenth Fire Control Region comprising the municipal districts of the City of Ararat, the Town of Stawell and the Shires of Ararat, Avoca, Lexton, Ripon and Stawell;
- the Seventeenth Fire Control Region comprising the municipal districts of the City of Horsham and the Shires of Arapiles, Dimboola, Dunmunkle, Kaniva, Kowree, Lowan, Warracknabeal and Wimmera;
- the Nineteenth Fire Control Region comprising the municipal districts of the Town of St. Arnaud and the Shires of Bet Bet, Kara Kara and Korong;
- the Twenty-third Fire Control Region comprising the municipal districts of the Cities of Benalla and Wangaratta and the Shires of Benalla, Mansfield, Oxley, Rutherglen, Wangaratta and Yarrawonga;
- the Twenty-fourth Fire Control Region comprising the municipal districts of the Shires of Beechworth, Bright, Chiltern, Myrtleford, Towong, Upper Murray, Wodonga and Yackandandah;
- the Twenty-sixth Fire Control Region comprising the municipal districts of the Cities of Chelsea and Dandenong and those portions of the Cities of Springvale and Waverley not included in the Metropolitan Fire District and those portions of the City of Frankston and the Shires of Berwick, Cranbourne and Mornington not included in the Eighth Fire Control Region and those portions of the Shire of Knox not included in the Thirteenth Fire Control Region;
- those portions of the Eighth Fire Control Region comprised by the municipal districts of the Borough of Wonthaggi and the Shire of Bass and those portions of the City of Frankston and the Shires of Berwick and Cranbourne not included in the Twenty-sixth Fire Control Region and French Island;
- those portions of the Eleventh Fire Control Region comprised by the municipal district of the Town of Bairnsdale;
- those portions of the Twentieth Fire Control Region comprised by the municipal districts of the Borough of Kerang and the Shires of Birchip, Charlton, Cohuna, Donald, Gordon, Kerang and Wycheproof;
- those portions of the Twenty-First Fire Control Region comprised by the municipal districts of the Shires of East Loddon, Huntly and Maldon and those portions of the Shire of Marong not included in the Second Fire Control Region; and
- those portions of the Twenty-second Fire Control Region comprised by the municipal districts of the City of Echuca and the Shires of Euroa, Goulburn, Tungamah and Violet Town.
