VICTORIA POLICE. FIRE AT THE BASIN. On Monday, 18th March, 1968. REWARD.

NOTICE is hereby given that a reward or rewards will be paid by the Government of Victoria in accordance with the conditions set out hereunder for information leading to the conviction of the person or persons guilty of lighting fires at or in the vicinity of Ferndale-road, The Basin, about 11.15 a.m., on Monday, 18th March, 1968, resulting in the burning of approximately 500 acres of scrub extending to the outskirts of Ferny Creek.

CONDITIONS.

- 1. The person or persons giving information leading to the conviction of any person in connexion with the lighting of the fires will receive such amount or amounts not exceeding \$1,000 as shall be determined by the Chief Commissioner of Police.
- 2. The person or persons entitled to any reward and the arrount or amounts payable to such person or persons shall be determined by the Chief Commissioner of Police. Any information, which will be treated as confidential, may be given at any time by telephoning the Superintendent, Criminal Investigation Branch (34 999, Extension 204), or the nearest Police Station.
