MISSING CHILD

\$5,000 REWARD

WHEREAS at St. Kilda, on the 10th August, 1968, about 5.15 p.m., a girl named Linda Jane Stilwell, aged seven years, was on the foreshore area and from that time and date she has not been seen: Now therefore notice is given that a reward of \$5,000 will be paid by the Government of Victoria in accordance with the conditions set out hereunder.

CONDITIONS.

1. The person or persons giving information leading to the location of Linda Jane Stilwell and to the apprehension of any person or persons who may have committed an offence connected with the disappearance of this girl will receive such amount or amounts as shall be determined by the Chief Commissioner of Police.
2. The person or persons entitled to any reward and the amount or amounts payable to such person or persons shall be determined by the Chief Commissioner of Police.

Any information, which will be treated as confidential, may be given at any time by telephoning the Superintendent, Criminal Investigation Branch (34 999, extension 204) or the nearest Police Station.
