PUBLIC SERVICE ACT 1958.

THE Public Service Board, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Public Service Act 1958*, hereby amends the Public Service (Public Service Board) Regulations as shown below:—

Regulation 23.

The words "or Professional Officer (Assistant, National Museum or Institute of Applied Science), Class "OP-1"" are deleted.

Regulation 25.

In sub-regulation (1) the expression "(a)" and the word "or" immediately preceding "(b)" and the whole of sub-clause "(b)" are deleted.

In sub-regulation (2) the following is deleted—

"Professional Officer (Assistant, National Museum or Institute of Applied Science), Class "OP-1".
English Expression.
General Knowledge.
Elementary Science."

In sub-regulation (4) the words "or Professional Officer (Assistant, National Museum or Institute of Applied Science), Class "OP-1"" are deleted.

PART IV.—SALARIES AND INCREMENTS.

DIVISION III.—PROFESSIONAL DIVISION.

Regulation 92.

In sub-regulation (4) (i) the words "or Professional Officer, Class "OP-1"" are deleted.

Regulation 95.

In sub-regulation (1) after the words "Library Officer, Class "LR-1"" delete the words "Professional Officer, Class "OP-1" (Assistant, National Museum or Institute of Applied Science)" and following the words "Class "DT-1"" delete the words "Class "LR-1" or Class "OP-1"" and insert in lieu thereof the words "Class "HT-1" or Class "LR-1"".

(iii) if an adult, classified as an Assistant, National Museum, Class "AN-1", the rate in the incremental range provided for that classification in Part "B" of the Third Schedule to the Board's Regulations which is one year in advance of the rate to which he would otherwise be entitled."
