At the Executive Council Chamber, Melbourne, the
sixteenth day of September, 1969.

PRESENT:

ELECTION OF A SENATOR FOR VICTORIA.

HIS Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria,
by and with the advice of the Executive Council
thereof, and in pursuance of the powers conferred by the
Senate Elections Act 1958, doth by this Order fix the
following dates for the purpose of the election of a Senator
for Victoria of the Parliament of the Commonwealth,
viz.:—

The issue of the writ—29th September, 1969.

The nomination of the candidates—7th October, 1969.

The polling—25th October, 1969.

The return of the writ—on or before the 24th Novem-
ber, 1969.

And doth appoint the Office of the Commonwealth
Electoral Officer, at Commonwealth Centre, corner Spring
and La Trobe streets, Melbourne, to be the place for the
nomination of candidates.

And the Honorable Sir Arthur Gordon Rylah, Her
Majesty's Chief Secretary for the State of Victoria, shall
give the necessary directions herein accordingly.
