## PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

I, THE Governor of the State of Victoria, in the Commonwealth of Australia, do hereby declare that I have this day assented, in Her Majesty's name, to the Bills passed by the Parliament of the said State, the titles whereof are hereunder set forth, together with the short titles, that is to say:—

No. 8017. "An Act relating to the Purchase by the Gas and Fuel Corporation of Victoria of the Gas Undertakings of The Gas Supply Company Limited and for other purposes." (*Gas and Fuel Corporation (The Gas Supply Company Limited) Act 1970.*)

No. 8018. "An Act to amend the *Labour and Industry Act 1958.*" (*Labour and Industry (Amendment) Act 1970.*)

## PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

WHEREAS by an Act of the Parliament of the State of Victoria passed in the nineteenth year of the reign of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II intituled the *Labour and Industry (Amendment) Act 1970*, it is among other things enacted that the several provisions of the said Act other than Section 12 shall come into operation on a day or the respective days fixed by proclamation or successive proclamations of the Governor in Council published in the *Government Gazette*:

Now therefore, I, the Governor of the State of Victoria, in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, do by this my Proclamation fix the twenty-seventh day of November, 1970, as the day upon which all the provisions of the said Act other than Section 12 shall come into operation.
