SCHOOL FIRES.

REWARD.

NOTICE is hereby given that a reward or rewards will be paid by the Government of Victoria in accordance with the conditions set out hereunder for information leading to the conviction of a person or persons guilty of any act of setting fire to school buildings or aiding and abetting such act.

CONDITIONS.

1. The person or persons giving information leading to the conviction of any person in connexion with an act of setting fire to a school building or aiding and abetting such act, will receive such amount or amounts not exceeding \$2,000 as shall be determined by the Chief Commissioner of Police.

2. The person or persons entitled to any reward and the amount or amounts payable to such person or persons shall be determined by the Chief Commissioner of Police.

Any information which will be treated as confidential, may be given at any time by telephoning the Superintendent, Criminal Investigation Branch (662 0911, Extension 204), or the nearest Police Station.
