EXEMPTION OF CERTAIN MOTOR BOATS FROM THE PROVISIONS OF PART II. OF THE MOTOR BOATING ACT 1961.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

I, THE Governor of the State of Victoria, in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, and in pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the provisions of section 6 of the *Motor Boating Act 1961* and all other powers thereunto enabling do hereby exempt from the provisions of Part II. of the *Motor Boating Act 1961* any motor boat used on the Victorian waters of the Hume Reservoir and Yarrowonga Weir which is controlled by a person ordinarily resident in the State of New South Wales who holds a locality permit for such motor boat issued in accordance with the provisions of the *Water Traffic Regulations—N.S.W.* made under the provisions of the *Maritime Services Act 1935*, as amended, of the State of New South Wales.

DECLARING AREAS TO BE PASTEURIZED MILK DISTRICTS.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

WHEREAS by section 4 of the *Milk Pasteurization Act 1958* it is amongst other things enacted that the Governor in Council may by proclamation declare any area specified in such proclamation to be a pasteurized milk district on and after a date specified in the proclamation: Now therefore I, the Governor of the State of Victoria by and with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, do by this my Proclamation hereby declare the areas specified in the Schedule hereto to be pasteurized milk districts on and after the first day of February, One thousand nine hundred and seventy.

SCHEDULE.

(1) All that portion of the municipal district of the Shire of Avon within the Parishes of Bundalaguah, Sale, Stratford, Nuntin, Yeerung, Meerlieu and Bengworden South.

(2) The Township of Seymour.
