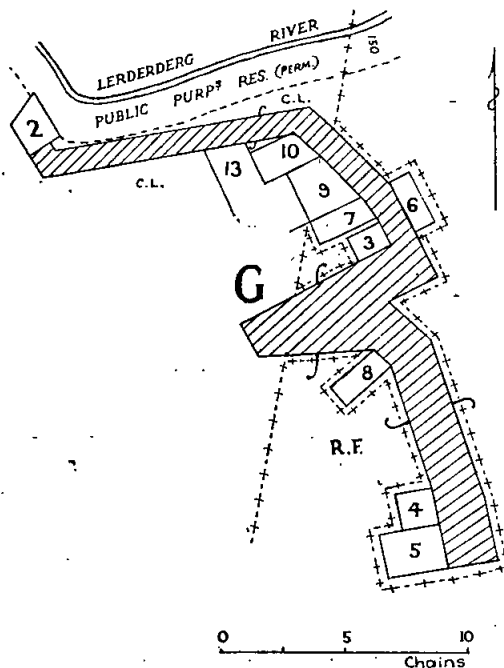

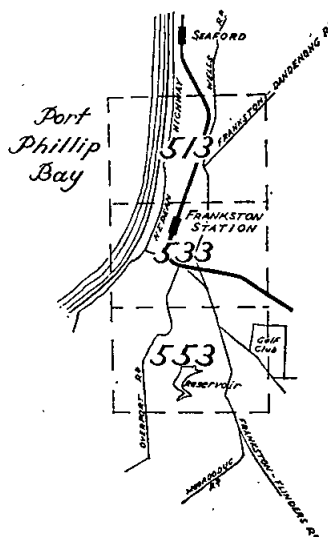

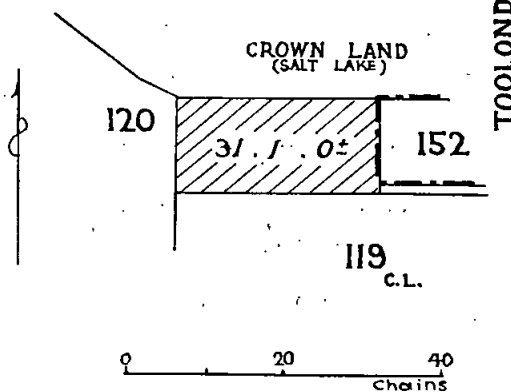

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

WHEREAS by the *Local Government Act 1958*, Section 519 it is amongst other things enacted that it shall be lawful for the Governor in Council at any time and from time to time upon request of the Council of any municipality by notice in the *Government Gazette* to proclaim any land reserved used or by purchase or exchange acquired for a street road highway thoroughfare bridge square court alley or right-of-way or any street road lane or passage made or laid out or proposed to be made or laid out on land of which a plan of subdivision delineating that street road lane or passage has been sealed with the seal of the municipality under subdivision (3) of Division 9 of Part XIX. of the *Local Government Act 1958*, or a corresponding previous enactment, to be a public highway and that such land shall thereupon and thenceforth from the date of such proclamation become and be absolutely dedicated to the public as a public highway within the meaning of any law then or thereafter in force:

AMENDMENT OF REGULATIONS FOR THE CARE, PROTECTION AND MANAGEMENT OF THE LAKE RESERVE NOW KNOWN AS THE "GRAMPIANS GATE CARAVAN AND CAMPING RESERVE" AT STAWELL.

WHEREAS in pursuance of section 218 of the *Land Act 1958* as then enacted the Board of Land and Works on 1st day of March, 1949, made regulations for the care, protection and management of certain Crown land in the Township of Stawell, Parish of Stawell,

reserved as a site for Public Gardens and the additional purpose of Public Recreation and Tourist Camp: And whereas the said Board was dissolved by the *Public Lands and Works Act 1964* which provided, *inter alia*, that all regulations made by the Board shall remain in force subject to the *Land Act 1958*: And whereas the Minister of Lands is now empowered to make regulations for or with respect to the said land (hereinafter called "the Reserve") in pursuance of section 218 of the *Land Act 1958*: And whereas it is expedient that the regulations made by the Board as aforesaid should be amended: Now therefore I, William John Farquhar McDonald, Her Majesty's Minister of Lands in and for the State of Victoria do hereby rescind the amending Regulation made by the Board of Land and Works on the 23rd June, 1960, and notified in the *Government Gazette* of the 6th July, 1960, making the following Regulation in lieu thereof:—
