ELECTION OF MEMBERS OF THE METROPOLITAN FIRE BRIGADES BOARD.

WHEREAS amongst other things it is enacted by the
Metropolitan Fire Brigades Act 1958 that all
elections of members of the Metropolitan Fire Brigades
Board shall be conducted in all respects whatsoever in
such manner as is prescribed by the Regulations and
every such election shall be held at such times and under
the direction of such returning officers as the Governor
in Council from time to time appoints:

And whereas the manner of conducting such elections
is prescribed in the Metropolitan Fire Brigades General
Regulations 1951:

Now therefore His Excellency the Governor of the State
of Victoria, by and with the advice of the Executive
Council thereof, and in pursuance of the *Metropolitan
Fire Brigades Act 1958* and all other powers him there-
unto enabling, doth by this Order appoint—

1. FRANCIS HENRY ROGAN, the Town Clerk of the City of
Melbourne, to be the Returning Officer for the election
of a member by the Council of the City of Melbourne.

2. (a) THURSDAY, the 4th June, 1970, to be the day for
holding the election of one member by the
Councils of the North Yarra Group and of
one member by the Councils of the South
Yarra Group of municipalities; and
- (b) CHARLES WALTER PHILLIPS, the Chief Electoral
Officer for Victoria, to be the Returning
Officer for such elections.
3. (a) THURSDAY, the 4th June, 1970, to be the day for
holding the election of members by the
insurance companies carrying on business and
insuring property within Victoria; and
- (b) HENRY FRANCIS HOLLOWAY, the Secretary of the
Fire and Accident Underwriters' Association
of Victoria, to be the Returning Officer for
such election.
4. (a) THURSDAY, the 4th June, 1970, to be the day for
holding the election of one member by the
officers and employees of the said Board;
and
- (b) CHARLES WALTER PHILLIPS, the Chief Electoral
Officer for Victoria, to be the Returning
Officer for such election.

And the Honorable Sir Arthur Gordon Rylah, Her
Majesty's Chief Secretary for the State of Victoria, shall
give the necessary directions herein accordingly.
