PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

IN pursuance of the provisions of Section 27 (1) of the Survey Co-Ordination (Place Names) Act 1965, I, the Governor of the State of Victoria, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, do hereby proclaim the physical feature formerly known as Cape Everard to be known as Point Hicks (C.O.S.100.)

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria aforesaid, at Melbourne, this eleventh day of November, in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and sixty-nine, and in the eighteenth year of the reign of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II.
