FISHERIES ACT 1968, No. 7780.

DATE OF OPERATION.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

WHEREAS by an Act of Parliament of the State of Victoria passed in the seventeenth year of the reign of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II. entitled the Fisheries Act 1968 (No. 7780), it is amongst other things enacted that the several provisions of this Act shall come into operation on the day or the respective days to be fixed by proclamation or successive proclamations of the Governor in Council published in the Government Gazette:

Now therefore I, the Governor of the State of Victoria, in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, do by this my proclamation fix Wednesday, the thirteenth day of May, One thousand nine hundred and seventy, as the day on which Sections 13, 14, 15, 16, 17 and 19 of Part III. and Sections 71 and 72 of Part VIII. of the said Fisheries Act 1968 (No. 7780) shall come into operation.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria aforesaid, at Melbourne, this thirteenth day of May, in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and seventy, and in the nineteenth year of the reign of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II.
