## PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

WHEREAS by sub-sections (2) and (3) of Section 172 of the Companies Act 1961 it is provided (inter alia) that the Governor in Council upon being satisfied that a prima facie case has been established that, for the protection of the public or the shareholders or creditors of a company it is desirable that the affairs of the company should be investigated under Division 4 of Part VI. of the said Act, may by proclamation published in the Government Gazette declare that such company is a company to which the said Division applies: Now therefore, I, the Governor for the State of Victoria, by and with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, being satisfied that such a prima facie case has been established that it is desirable that the affairs of the under-mentioned companies should be investigated under the said Division, do in and by this my proclamation declare that such companies are companies to which the said Division applies:
