## ELECTION OF SENATORS FOR VICTORIA.

HIS Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria, by and with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, and in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Senate Elections Act 1958, doth by this Order fix the following dates for the purpose of the election of Senators for Victoria of the Parliament of the Commonwealth, viz.:—

The issue of the writ-16th October, 1970.

The nomination of the candidates—29th October, 1970.

The polling-21st November, 1970.

The return of the writ—on or before 7th January, 1971. And doth appoint the Office of the Commonwealth Electoral Officer, at Commonwealth Centre, corner Spring and Latrobe streets, Melbourne, to be the place for the nomination of candidates.

And the Honorable Sir Arthur Gordon Rylah, Her Majesty's Chief Secretary for the State of Victoria, shall give the necessary directions herein accordingly.
