SOCIAL WELFARE ACT 1970, No. 8089.  
DATE OF COMING INTO OPERATION.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

**WHEREAS** by an Act of Parliament of the State of Victoria passed in the nineteenth year of the reign of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II, entitled the *Social Welfare Act 1970*, No. 8089, it is amongst other things enacted that the provisions of the said Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation of the Governor in Council published in the *Government Gazette*:

Now therefore I, the Governor of the State of Victoria, in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, do by this my Proclamation fix Tuesday, the fifth day of January, One thousand nine hundred and seventy-one, as the day on which the whole of the said *Social Welfare Act 1970*, No. 8089, shall come into operation.

SOCIAL WELFARE ACT 1970.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

**WHEREAS** by sub-section (2) of section 79 of the *Social Welfare Act 1970* it is provided that the street-trading provisions of Division 9 of Part II. of the said Act shall apply only within such portion or portions of Victoria as are specified by proclamation of the Governor in Council published in the *Government Gazette*:

Now therefore, I the Governor of the State of Victoria in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, do by this my Proclamation specify the City of Melbourne only as the portion of Victoria within which the said provisions shall apply.
