MINISTRY FOR THE ARTS ACT 1972, No. 8357.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

Whereas by an Act of Parliament of the State of Victoria passed in the twenty-first year of the reign of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II., entitled the *Ministry for the Arts Act 1972, No. 8357*, it is amongst other things enacted that the Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by Proclamation of the Governor in Council published in the *Government Gazette*:

Now therefore, I, the Governor of the State of Victoria in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, do by this my Proclamation fix Tuesday, the nineteenth day of December, One thousand nine hundred and seventy-two as the day on which the said *Ministry for the Arts Act 1972*, shall come into operation.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria aforesaid, at Melbourne, this nineteenth day of December, in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and seventy-two, and in the twenty-first year of the reign of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II.
