## REGULATIONS.—PART IV.—SALARIES AND INCREMENTS.

The Public Service Board, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Public Service Act 1958*, hereby amends the Public Service (Public Service Board) Regulations as on and from the 28th May, 1972 as follows :—

The First, Second, Third, Fourth, Fifth, Sixth and Seventh Schedules to these Regulations are revoked and the following Schedules substituted therefor :—
