Sports Promotion Act 1972 No. 8289.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c. &c.

Whereas by sub-section (2) of Section 1 of the Sports Promotion Act 1972 No. 8289 it is provided that the said Act shall come into operation on a day or days to be fixed by proclamation or successive proclamations of the Governor in Council published in the Government Gazette:

Now therefore I, the Lieutenant-Governor of the State of Victoria in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State do by this my Proclamation fix Wednesday, the twelfth day of July, One thousand nine hundred and seventy-two, as the day on which the whole of Part II. of the said Act shall come into operation.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria aforesaid, at Melbourne, this eleventh day of July, in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and seventy-two, and in the twenty-first year of the reign of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II.
