FIRES WITHIN THE CITY OF KNOX.

REWARD

Notice is hereby given that a reward or rewards will be paid by the Government of Victoria and the City of Knox in accordance with the conditions set out hereunder for information leading to the conviction of any person or persons guilty of any act of illegally lighting a fire causing damage to property within the Municipal District of the City of Knox, or aiding and abetting such Act.

CONDITIONS.

1. The person or persons giving information leading to the conviction of any person in connexion with the act of lighting such a fire or aiding and abetting such act, will receive such amount or amounts not exceeding \$2,000 as shall be determined by the Chief Commissioner of Police.

2. The person or persons entitled to any reward and the amount or amounts payable to such person or persons shall be determined by the Chief Commissioner of Police.

3. The offer of this reward will remain open until the 30th day of June, 1973.
