PROCLAMATION

Whereas by an Act of Parliament of the State of Victoria passed in the twenty-first year of the reign of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II, entitled the Weights and Measures (Amendment) Act 1972, No. 3368, it is amongst other things enacted that the said Act shall come into operation on a day or successive days to be fixed by proclamation or proclamations of the Governor in Council published in the Government Gazette.
