Whereas by Division 12 of Part 1 of the *Land Act 1958*, it is amongst other things enacted that the Governor in Council may from time to time increase and after one month's notice in the *Government Gazette* diminish, alter, or abolish any common, and may from time to time re-proclaim the whole or any part of any such common for any of the purposes and subject to the provisions of the said Part of the said Act, and that nothing therein contained shall prevent the exercise of the powers conferred by the said Part of the said Act with respect to the leasing or licensing of any land comprised in any common: And whereas notice of the intention to diminish the Caramut Town Common has been duly published in the *Government Gazette* for one month:

Now, therefore I, the Governor of the State of Victoria, in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State do hereby diminish the Caramut Town Common by the excision therefrom of 14 acres, more or less, in the Township of Caramut as defined by the description published in the *Government Gazette* of the 2nd May, 1973.—(Corres. No. Rs.417.)

Now therefore, I, the Governor of the State of Victoria, by and with the advice of the Executive Council thereof and with effect on and from the 4th day of July, 1973, hereby proclaim the Borough of Kyabram to be a Town under the name of the Town of Kyabram.



REGULATIONS FOR THE CARE, PROTECTION AND MANAGEMENT OF THE "THE ALBERT RICHARDSON RESERVE".

I, William Archibald Borthwick, Her Majesty's Minister of Lands in and for the State of Victoria, in pursuance of the powers conferred on me by section 218 of the *Land Act* 1958, do hereby make the following Regulations for or with respect to the land in the Parish of Sandhurst temporarily reserved by Order in Council dated the 11th April, 1962, as a site for Public Recreation and hereinafter referred to as "the Reserve".

The Reserve has been placed under the control of the Corporation of the City of Bendigo as the Committee of Management (hereinafter referred to as "the Committee") with power and authority to enforce the following Regulations:

REGULATIONS.

1. The Reserve shall be open to the public from sunrise to sunset, free of charge, except on such days (not exceeding 26 in any one year) as the Reserve or portions thereof may be set apart for cricket or football matches, fetes, sports, or holiday or other amusements on any of which occasions a charge, deemed to be reasonable by the Committee, may be made and taken for admission to the Reserve. All applications for the use of the Reserve must be lodged in writing with the Secretary of the Committee fourteen days before the Reserve is required.

2. No person shall—

- Enter or remain in the Reserve who may offend against decency as regards dress, language or conduct, behave in a disorderly or offensive manner or create or take part in any disturbance.
- Enter or remain in the Reserve whilst under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
- Climb or jump over the gates or fences in or around the Reserve, stick bills or posters thereon or cut names on or in any way damage, mark or injure any of the buildings, gates, fences, seats, lawns or trees in the Reserve, nor roll or throw stones or any missiles of any kind therein.

- (d) Remove, deface, or displace any board, plate or fitting, written or printed notice for the exhibition of any Regulations, or notice fixed or set up by the Committee in the Reserve.
 - (e) Light a fire in the Reserve except at places as are set apart by the Committee for such purpose.
 - (f) Remain within the Reserve or on any property therein when lawfully directed to leave the same by any Bailiff of Crown lands or member of the Police Force or authorized officer of the Committee.
 - (g) On or upon the Reserve, kill, wound, trap or snare or attempt to kill, wound, trap or snare any bird or other native game, or have any dead bird or other native game or the skin or pelt thereof, in his possession.
 - (h) Dig or remove any sand, soil, stone or other material from the Reserve.
 - (i) Break glass of any kind or leave or deposit any matter or thing injurious to persons.
 - (j) Deposit or leave any unwanted material or thing or rubbish of any kind on any part of the Reserve except in receptacles provided for that purpose by the Committee.
 - (k) Camp in the Reserve or in any of the buildings therein.
 - (l) Obstruct, hinder or interfere with any person employed at the Reserve.
 - (m) Ride a horse, bicycle or motor cycle or drive a motor vehicle or any other vehicle within the Reserve recklessly or in a manner which is dangerous to the public having regard to all the circumstances of the case.
 - (n) Carry or discharge any firearms or air guns in the Reserve.
 - (o) Spit or expectorate or commit any nuisance on the paths or in or on any building, structure or erection in the Reserve.
 - (p) Interfere with or interrupt any game, sports, competition or entertainment or amusement or practice thereat.
 - (q) Obtain or attempt to obtain admission to any part of the Reserve when not entitled to admission under these Regulations.
3. No person shall without the written consent of the Committee—
- (a) Bring into or sell or distribute in the Reserve any intoxicating liquor unless holding a licence or permit as required pursuant to the provisions of the *Liquor Control Act 1968*, and then only in such place or places or portion of the Reserve as may be set apart for the purpose by the Committee.
 - (b) Bring into the Reserve any cattle, horses, sheep, goats, pigs or other animals nor permit the same to enter.
 - (c) Bring into the Reserve a dog unless such dog is and continues to be at all times controlled by a chain or leash.
 - (d) Exercise or train any horse, pony or dog in the Reserve.
 - (e) Play, practise or engage in any organized game, sport or entertainment in the Reserve.
 - (f) Cause or permit any outcry, sound or noise to be emitted from an amplifier, loud speaker, public address system or like instrument.
 - (g) Hawk or sell or offer for sale within the Reserve any goods, fruit or merchandise or anything whatsoever or solicit or gather money therein.
 - (h) Play or perform in any band of music or deliver or read any public speech, lecture, prayer or sermon or address of any kind, sing any sacred or secular song or enter into any public assemblage on the Reserve.
 - (i) Cut, saw, dig, move or displace any tree, bough, live or dead timber, wood or other material which may be in or around the Reserve.
 - (j) Park any motor vehicle, caravan, trailer or other vehicle in the Reserve provided that the Committee may from time to time make a charge should it permit such parking.
 - (k) Enter, cross, be on or trespass on any playing ground area, enclosure or course or building, room or structure or any part thereof whilst

any sport, game, competition, race, entertainment or amusement is being played, conducted or carried on or at any time between the commencement and conclusion of such event.—(Rs.8124.)



The Teachers Tribunal, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Teaching Service Act 1958*, hereby repeals the *Teaching Service—Professional (Classification, Salaries, and Allowances) Regulation* and makes the following Regulation, to take effect on the 10th June, 1973.

TEACHING SERVICE—PROFESSIONAL (CLASSIFICATION, SALARIES, AND ALLOWANCES) REGULATION.

1. This Regulation may be cited as the “Teaching Service—Professional (Classification, Salaries, and Allowances) Regulation”.

2. Interpretation.

The term “subdivision” in this Regulation means salary subdivision and represents a point of the salary scale on which a professional officer must serve for a minimum of one year before being eligible to progress to any higher subdivision within the range prescribed for the position held.

3. Salaries and Allowances.

- (a) Unless specified otherwise all salaries and allowances prescribed in this Regulation are annual rates.
- (b) Within the salary range prescribed for any professional position, the occupant, subject to satisfactory service, shall proceed by annual increments from the minimum to the maximum of the range.

Provided that the Tribunal may determine that an appointee shall commence at a rate other than the minimum.

4. Schedule of Rates.

Excluding the rates prescribed in clause 6 of this Regulation, the salaries of professional officers shall be prescribed within the following schedule of rates:—

7. *Higher Duties.*

- (a) Where a member of the Teaching Service is assigned the duties of a professional position carrying a higher remuneration than that applicable to his permanent position, and the Tribunal has consented to such duties being assigned for a period of more than two weeks, he shall be paid a higher duties allowance in accordance with this clause.
- (b) A member assigned to a position carrying a total remuneration of less than \$13,747 a year shall receive an allowance equivalent to the minimum of the salary attributable to the position to which he has been assigned.

Provided that, if his current salary exceeds or is equivalent to the minimum of the salary attributable to the position to which he has been assigned, he shall receive an allowance equivalent to the nearest subdivisional rate within the range of the position to which assigned which will result in an increase in his normal remuneration.

- (c) A member assigned to a position carrying a total remuneration of \$13,747 a year, or more, shall be paid a higher duties allowance as determined by the Tribunal.
- (d) Where a member temporarily occupies a higher position, but does not perform the whole of the duties usually performed by the holder of that position he may be paid such allowance as may be determined by the Tribunal.
- (e) Without the prior approval of the Tribunal, no member shall be assigned the duties of any position for a period exceeding one calendar year.
