EDUCATION ACT 1958, No. 6240.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

Whereas Part IIIA of the Education Act 1958 was brought into operation on the first day of July, one thousand nine hundred and seventy-two by Proclamation published in the Government Gazette on the twenty-eighth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and seventy-two:

And whereas the provisions of section 52 o of the said Act have effect from a day to be specified by the Governor in Council for the purposes of the said section by Proclamation published in the Government Gazette, being a day not more than twelve months after the commencement of the said Part:

Now therefore I, the Governor of the State of Victoria, acting by and with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, do by this my Proclamation specify Saturday, the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and seventy-three as the day from which the said section 52 o of the said Act shall have effect.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria aforesaid, at Melbourne, this twenty-sixth day of June, in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and seventy-three, and in the twenty-second year of the reign of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II.
