CONSTITUTION ACT AMENDMENT ACT 1958
AND PARLIAMENTARY CONTRIBUTORY SUPER-
ANNUATION ACT 1962.

At the Executive Council Chamber, Melbourne, the
twenty-fourth day of July, 1973.

PRESENT:

His Excellency the Governor of Victoria.

Whereas pursuant to the provisions of sub-section (4) of section 37 of *The Constitution Act Amendment Act 1958* and sub-section (5) of section 2 of the *Parliamentary Contributory Superannuation Act 1962*, the Governor in Council shall by order published in the *Government Gazette* within 31 days after the 30th June in each year declare the amount that in his opinion having regard to any awards of the Commonwealth Conciliation and Arbitration Commission is the amount by which the minimum wage has been increased between the 1st day of December, 1968, and the 30th day of June then last past; now therefore His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria, by and with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, doth by this Order declare that \$21.20 is the amount by which the minimum wage has been increased between 1st day of December, 1968, and the 30th day of June, 1973.

And the Honorable Rupert James Hamer, Her Majesty's Premier for the State of Victoria, shall give the necessary directions herein accordingly.
