HISTORIC BUILDINGS ACT 1974, No. 8569.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

Whereas by sub-section (2) of section 1 of the *Historic Buildings Act 1974* (No. 8569) it is provided that the several provisions of the said Act shall come into operation on a day or the respective days to be fixed by proclamation of the Governor in Council published in the *Government Gazette*.

Now therefore, I, the Governor of the State of Victoria in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, do by this proclamation fix Friday, the 27th day of September, One thousand nine hundred and seventy-four as the day on which the provisions of the said Act other than section 23 and paragraphs (a) (b) (c) and (e) of section 24 shall come into operation.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria aforesaid, at Melbourne, the twenty-fifth day of September, in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and seventy-four, and in the twenty-third year of the reign of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II.
