SEVERANCE OF A PORTION OF THE SHIRE OF WANGARATTA AND ANNEXATION THEREOF TO THE CITY OF WANGARATTA.

Pursuant to section 23 of the *Local Government Act 1958*, His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria, by and with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, and in compliance with an application of the Council of the City of Wangaratta, hereby orders:—

- (1) That the portion of the municipal district of the Shire of Wangaratta described hereunder shall be severed from the Killawarra Riding of the said Shire and annexed to the City of Wangaratta;
- (2) That for the purpose of any financial settlement between the municipalities this Order shall take effect on and from 1st October, 1975, and for all other purposes shall take effect from the 31st May, 1975;
- (3) That this Order shall not affect the retirement in accordance with the provisions of Division 2 of Part III. of the said Act of Councillors of the said municipalities:

PORTION TO BE SEVERED FROM THE SHIRE OF WANGARATTA AND ANNEXED TO THE CITY OF WANGARATTA.

Commencing at a point on the Hume Highway at its intersection with the Three Mile Creek on the south-western boundary of Allotment 11A, section 31, Parish of Wangaratta South; thence generally southerly by the Hume Highway to the road forming the southern boundary of allotment 20B, section 31; thence westerly by that road to the road forming the western boundary of allotment 20A, section 31; thence northerly by that road to the road forming the northern boundary of allotment 23A, section 31; thence easterly by that road to the Three Mile Creek; thence generally southerly by that creek to the Hume Highway being the point of commencement.
