APPOINTMENT OF COMMISSIONER.—CITY OF KEILOR.

Whereas it is provided in section 13 of the *Local Government Act 1958* that where any councillors of a municipality refuse or neglect to attend or to remain in attendance at meetings of the council so that a quorum cannot be formed or maintained, the Governor in Council may by Order to be published in the *Government Gazette* appoint some fit and proper person to be a commissioner of such municipality; and

Whereas certain councillors of the City of Keilor have refused or neglected to attend meetings of the Council so that a quorum of the Council cannot be formed or maintained;

Now therefore His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria by and with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, doth by this Order appoint Kevin Miles Holland to be the Commissioner of the City of Keilor, and determine that the salary to be paid to him out of the municipal fund of the said municipality shall be at the rate of \$200 per week.

And the Honorable Alan John Hunt, Her Majesty's Minister for Local Government, shall give the necessary directions herein accordingly.
