ELECTION OF SENATORS FOR VICTORIA.

His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria, by and with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, and in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Senate Elections Act 1958*, doth by this Order fix the following dates for the purpose of the election of Senators for Victoria of the Parliament of the Commonwealth, viz.:—

The issue of the writ—17th November, 1975.

The nomination of the candidates—28th November, 1975.

The polling—13th December, 1975.

The return of the writ—on or before 22nd January, 1976.

And doth appoint the Office of the Australian Electoral Officer for Victoria at Australian Government Centre, corner Spring and La Trobe Streets, Melbourne, to be the place for the nomination of candidates.

And the Honorable John Frederick Rossiter, Her Majesty's Chief Secretary for the State of Victoria, shall give the necessary directions herein accordingly.
