PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c.; &c.

I, the Governor of the State of Victoria, in the Commonwealth of Australia, do hereby declare that I have this day assented, in Her Majesty's name, to the Bills passed by the Parliament of the said State, the titles whereof are hereunder set forth, together with the short titles, that is to say:—

- No. 8826. "An Act to constitute a Joint Select Committee to inquire into and report on the Law and Practice governing the Conduct of Public Servants in Cases where their Official Duties and Private Interests conflict, and for other purposes." (*Public Servants Ethical Conduct (Joint Select Committee) Act 1976.*)
- No. 8827. "An Act to amend the *Parliamentary Committees Act 1968*, the *Public Works Committee Act 1958* and the *State Development Committee Act 1958*, with respect to the Membership of certain Committees." (*Committees (Membership) Act 1976.*)
- No. 8828. "An Act to provide for the Appointment of a Joint Select Committee of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly to Inquire into and Report upon Certain Questions relating to the Meat Industry in Victoria, and for other purposes." (*Joint Select Committee (Meat Industry) Act 1976.*)
- No. 8829. "An Act to provide for the Appointment of a Joint Select Committee of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly to Inquire into and Report upon Certain Questions relating to Road Safety, and for other purposes." (*Joint Select Committee (Road Safety) Act 1976.*)

Marketing of Primary Products Act 1958.

DECLARING THAT ORANGES, MANDARINS AND GRAPEFRUIT SHALL BECOME THE PROPERTY OF THE CITRUS FRUIT MARKETING BOARD FOR A PERIOD OF TWO (2) YEARS.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c.; &c.

Whereas by sub-section (1) of section 17 of the *Marketing of Primary Products Act 1958*, it is enacted that where a product has been declared a commodity and a board has been appointed in relation thereto, the Governor in Council may by proclamation—

- (a) provide and declare that the commodity shall forthwith upon the date of publication of the proclamation or on, from and after a later date specified in the proclamation, be divested from the producers of the commodity and become vested in and be the absolute property of the board as the owner thereof, and that upon any of the commodity coming into existence within a time specified in the same or a subsequent proclamation it shall by virtue of that Act become vested in and be the absolute property of the board as the owner thereof; and
- (b) make such further provision as will enable the board effectively to obtain possession of the commodity as such owner and to deal with the same:

And whereas by a proclamation made on the sixth day of February, 1973 under the provisions of section 7 of the said Act the Governor in Council declared oranges, mandarins and grapefruit to be a commodity under and for the purposes of the said Act: And whereas by an Order made on the fourth day of December, 1973 the Governor in Council appointed a marketing board in relation to oranges, mandarins and grapefruit and assigned to such board the name of "The Citrus Fruit Marketing Board": Now therefore, I, the Governor of the State of Victoria in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, do by this my proclamation hereby provide and declare that on, from and after the fifteenth day of May, 1976, all oranges, mandarins and grapefruit shall subject to and in accordance with the *Marketing of Primary Products Act 1958* be divested from the producers thereof and become vested in and be the absolute property of The Citrus-Fruit-Marketing

Board as the owner thereof and that upon any oranges, mandarins or grapefruit coming into existence within two (2) years from the fifteenth day of May, 1976, they shall, by virtue of and subject to and in accordance with the said Act become vested in and be the absolute property of The Citrus Fruit Marketing Board as the owner thereof: And to enable The Citrus Fruit Marketing Board as the owner of the abovementioned commodity effectively to obtain possession thereof and to deal with the same I do further provide that all such oranges, mandarins and grapefruit shall subject to and in accordance with the provisions of the said Act be delivered by the producers thereof to The Citrus Fruit Marketing Board or its authorized agent within such times at such places and in such manner as The Citrus Fruit Marketing Board by public notice, or in a particular case in writing, directs or as are prescribed by Regulations made under the said Act.

Marketing of Primary Products Act 1958.

DECLARING THAT TOBACCO LEAF SHALL BECOME THE PROPERTY OF THE TOBACCO LEAF MARKETING BOARD FOR A FURTHER PERIOD OF TWO (2) YEARS.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

Whereas by sub-section (1) of section 17 of the *Marketing of Primary Products Act 1958*, it is enacted that where a product has been declared a commodity and a board has been appointed in relation thereto, the Governor in Council may by proclamation—

- (a) provide and declare that the commodity shall forthwith upon the date of publication of the proclamation or on, from and after a later date specified in the proclamation, be divested from the producers of the commodity and become vested in and be the absolute property of the board as the owner thereof, and that upon any of the commodity coming into existence within a time specified in the same or subsequent proclamation it shall by virtue of the said Act become vested in and be the absolute property of the board as the owner thereof; and
- (b) make such further provision as will enable the board effectively to obtain possession of the commodity as such owner and to deal with the same:

And whereas by a proclamation made on the twentieth day of December 1963, under the provisions of section 7 of the said Act the Governor in Council declared tobacco leaf to be a commodity under and for the purposes of the said Act: And whereas by an Order made on the twenty-second day of April, 1964, the Governor in Council appointed a marketing board in relation to tobacco leaf and assigned to such board the name of "The Tobacco Leaf Marketing Board": Now therefore, I, the Governor of the State of Victoria in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, do by this my proclamation hereby provide and declare that on, from and after the thirteenth day of May, 1976, all tobacco leaf shall subject to and in accordance with the *Marketing of Primary Products Act 1958* be divested from the producers of tobacco leaf and become vested in and be the absolute property of The Tobacco Leaf Marketing Board as the owner thereof: And to enable The Tobacco Leaf Marketing Board as the owner of the abovementioned commodity effectively to

obtain possession thereof and to deal with the same I do further provide that all such tobacco leaf shall subject to and in accordance with the provisions of the said Act be delivered by the producers thereof to The Tobacco Leaf Marketing Board or its authorized agent within such times at such places and in such manner as The Tobacco Leaf Marketing Board by public notice, or in a particular case in writing, directs or as are prescribed by Regulations made under the said Act.

JURIES ACT 1967.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

Whereas:

- I. It is provided by sub-section 2 of section 9 of the *Juries Act 1967* that if pursuant to the powers contained in *The Constitution Act Amendment Act 1958* or any other Act a redivision of the State into electoral districts for the Legislative Assembly is adopted or is deemed to be adopted and such electoral districts are divided into subdivisions the Governor in Council may by proclamation published in the *Government Gazette* determine which of such new electoral districts or subdivisions thereof shall comprise the jury district for each Supreme Court Town and County Court town and Schedules 5 and 6 to the said *Juries Act 1967* shall be deemed to be amended accordingly as from the date specified in such proclamation.
- II. Pursuant to the powers contained in *The Constitution Act Amendment Act 1958* a redivision of the State into electoral districts for the Legislative Assembly has been adopted and such electoral districts are divided into subdivisions.

Now therefore I, the Governor of the State of Victoria, by and with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, do by this my Proclamation determine that as from the first day of May 1976 Schedules 5 and 6 of the *Juries Act 1967* shall be deemed to be as set out hereunder—

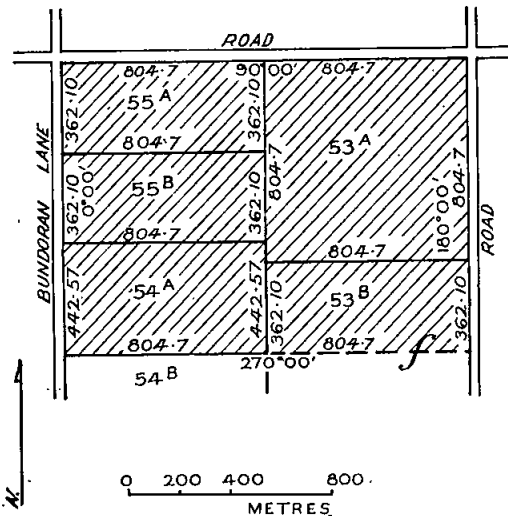
By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

Whereas by Section 15 of the *Archaeological and Aboriginal Relics Preservation Act 1972*, it is amongst other things enacted that where the Governor in Council is satisfied with respect to any land—

- (a) that it is necessary to reserve the land for the preservation of relics therein;
- (b) that for the preservation of relics therein it is necessary to control the entry of persons upon that land;
- (c) that satisfactory arrangements have been made or will be made for the management of the land as an archaeological area and for controlling the entry of persons upon the land; and
- (d) all consents required by the Act have been obtained—

he may by proclamation published in the *Government Gazette* declare the land to be an archaeological area:

Now therefore, I, the Governor of the State of Victoria in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State and on being satisfied on the matters aforesaid do by this my proclamation declare all that piece of land being Crown allotments 55A, 55B, 54A, 53A and portion of allotment 53B, Parish of Bilpah, County of Villiers as indicated on the plan hereunder to be an Archaeological Area:—

PUBLIC HIGHWAY.—SHIRE OF WERRIBEE.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

Whereas by the *Local Government Act 1958*, section 519 it is amongst other things enacted that it shall be lawful for the Governor in Council at any time and from time to time upon the request of the Council of any municipality by notice in the *Government Gazette* to proclaim any land reserved used or by purchase or exchange acquired for a street road highway thoroughfare bridge square court alley

or right-of-way or any street road lane or passage made or laid out or proposed to be made or laid out on any land of which a plan of subdivision delineating that street road lane or passage has been sealed with the seal of the municipality under sub-division (3) of Division 9 Part XIX of the *Local Government Act 1958* or a corresponding previous enactment to be a public highway and that such land shall thereupon and thence forth from the date of such proclamation become and be absolutely dedicated to the public as a public highway within the meaning of any law then or thereafter in force.

And whereas the Council of the Shire of Werribee has requested that the land hereinafter mentioned, being a street, road, lane or passage made or laid out or proposed to be made or laid out on land of which a plan of subdivision delineating the streets roads lanes or passages has been sealed with the seal of the municipality under sub-division (3) of Division 9 of Part XIX of the *Local Government Act 1958*, or a corresponding previous enactment and being land used for a street or road, be so declared to be a public highway.

Now therefore, I, the Governor of the State of Victoria in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the State, do by this proclamation declare that Plummer Road, coloured brown on Plan of Subdivision No. 40605 lodged at the Office of Titles shall be a public highway within the meaning of the said Act.

Country Fire Authority Act 1958.

VARIATION OF FIRE DANGER PERIOD IN RESPECT OF SPECIFIED PARTS OF THE COUNTRY AREAS OF VICTORIA.

Whereas by section 4 of the *Country Fire Authority Act 1958*, it is enacted that the Chief Secretary of Victoria, after consultation with the Minister of Forests, may from time to time by declaration published in the *Government Gazette* declare any period to be the fire danger period in respect of the country area of Victoria, or any specified part or parts thereof and, without affecting the generality of the foregoing, may declare different periods to be the fire danger period in respect of different parts of the said country area:

And whereas by the said section it is further enacted that any declaration so published may be revoked, amended or varied by a subsequent declaration so published:

And whereas by declaration issued on the date stated in Schedule A annexed hereto, different fire danger periods expiring on the thirtieth day of April, 1976, were declared in respect of different parts of the country area of Victoria, situated within the municipal districts or parts of municipal districts specified in Schedule B hereunder:

And whereas the Chief Secretary and the Minister of Forests have consulted accordingly:

Now therefore I, the Chief Secretary of Victoria, do by this my declaration vary the aforesaid declaration by declaring that the fire danger period in respect of the parts of the country area of Victoria situated within the municipal districts or parts of municipal districts specified in Schedule B hereunder shall end at midnight on the 23rd of April, 1976.

Forests Act 1958, No. 6254.

VARIATION OF PROHIBITED PERIOD.

In pursuance of the powers conferred by section 3 of the Forests Act 1958, I, Frederick James Granter, Her Majesty's Minister of Forests in the State of Victoria, hereby vary the declarations of Prohibited Periods previously made by me in the Government Gazettes of the 10th December, 1975, and the 17th December, 1975, in so far as they refer to the municipalities specified hereunder, and by this notice declare that in these specified municipalities the Prohibited Period in respect of any fire protected area (other than a State forest, national park or protected public land) shall end at midnight between Friday, 23rd April and Saturday, 24th April, 1976.

PARISH OF LAURISTON



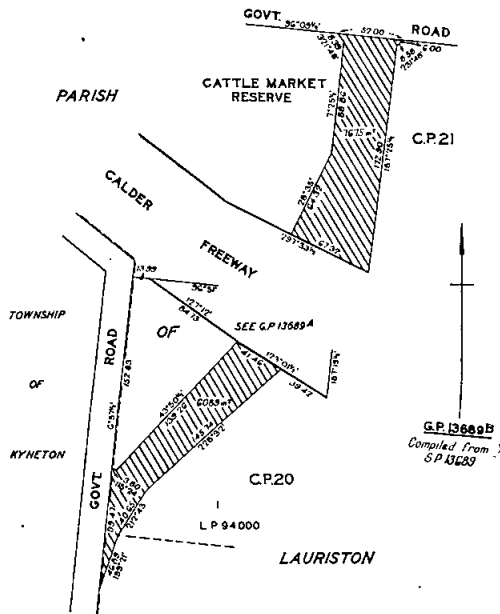

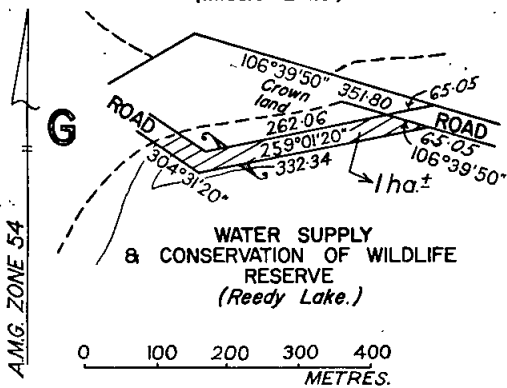
