

DECLARING NEWCASTLE DISEASE AND FOWL PLAGUE TO BE PROCLAIMED DISEASES FOR THE PURPOSES OF PART III.

#### PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

Whereas by section 38 of the Stock Diseases Act 1968 it is amongst other things provided that "Proclaimed Disease" mean a disease of stock—

- (a) not present in Australia; or
- (b) not ordinarily present in Australia-

which is declared by Proclamation of the Governor in Council published in the Government Gazette to be a disease for the purposes of Part III of the said Act:

Now therefore I, the Governor of the State of Victoria by and with the advice of the Executive Council thereof do by this my Proclamation declare the following diseases, which are not normally present in Australia, to be Proclaimed diseases for the purposes of Part III of the said Stock Diseases Act 1968:—


