## PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

Whereas by an Act of Parliament of the State of Victoria passed in the twenty-fifth year of the reign of Her Majesty Elizabeth II, Queen of Australia, entitled the Judges Salaries Act 1976, No. 8853, it is amongst other things enacted that the several provisions of the said Act shall come into operation on a day or the respective days to be fixed by proclamation or successive proclamations of the Government Gazette:

Now therefore, I, the Governor of the State of Victoria in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, do by this my Proclamation fix Tuesday, the eighth day of June, One thousand, nine hundred and seventy-six, as the day on which the whole of the said Act shall come into operation.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria aforesaid at Melbourne, this eighth day of June, in the year of Our Lord One thousand, nine hundred and seventy-six, and in the twenty-fifth year of the reign of Her Majesty Elizabeth II, Queen of Australia.
