POLICE REGULATION (AMENDMENT) ACT 1977 No. 9066

DATE OF COMING INTO OPERATION

### PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

Whereas by an Act of Parliament of the State of Victoria passed in the twenty-sixth year of the reign of Her Majesty Elizabeth the Second, Queen of Australia, entitled the Police Regulation (Amendment) Act 1977 No. 9066 it is amongst other things enacted that the several provisions of the said Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by Proclamation of the Governor in Council published in the Government Gazette.

Now therefore I, the Governor of the State of Victoria, in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, do by this my proclamation fix Wednesday the seventh day of December, One thousand nine hundred and seventy-seven as the day on which the whole of the said Police Regulation (Amendment) Act 1977 No. 9066 shall come into operation.
