- (a) cancelling capital to the extent of 50 cents in respect of each of the 645,000 fully paid ordinary shares of 50 cents each held by Leighton Staff Shares Pty. Limited ("the Trustee") as Trustee of the Leighton Staff Share Scheme;
- (b) (i) returning capital in cash to the extent of 50 cents for each of the said 645,000 shares held by the Trustee;

(ii) returning capital in cash to the extent of a further \$2.25 for each of the 528,000 of the said 645,000 shares held by the Trustee that were issued to the Trustee at a premium of \$2.25 by payment to the Trustee of the sum of \$1,188,000 from the share premium account of the Company conditionally upon the Trustee simultaneously therewith paying to the Company and those of its subsidiaries to which the Trustee is indebted the full amount of its indebtedness to them, namely the aggregate sum of \$1,496,650.
