## PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

Whereas by an Act of Parliament of the State of Victoria passed in the Twenty-fourth year of the reign of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II., entitled the Fisheries Act 1975 (No. 8694), it is amongst other things enacted that the several provisions of this Act shall come into operation on the day or the respective days to be fixed by proclamation or successive proclamations of the Governor in Council published in the Government Gazette.

Now, therefore I, the Governor of the State of Victoria in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, do by this my Proclamation fix Monday the seventh day of February One thousand nine hundred and seventy-seven as the day on which—Sub-section (3) of Section 3 of the said Fisheries Act 1975 (No. 8694) shall come into operation.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria aforesaid, at Melbourne, this second day of February, in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and seventy-seven, and in the twenty-fifth year of the reign of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II.
