REWARD

Notice is hereby given that a reward of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000) will be paid by the Government of Victoria for information leading to the apprehension and conviction of the person or persons responsible for the death of Mrs. Florence Edna Handley, who was attacked whilst walking along Gracie Street, North Melbourne on Saturday, 1 July, 1978. Mrs. Handley died as a result of a stab wound inflicted during the attack.

The allocation of the said \$50,000 will be at the sole discretion of the Chief Commissioner of Police.
