Date of Coming into Operation

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

Whereas by an Act of Parliament of the State of Victoria passed in the twenty-seventh year of the reign of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II entitled the Racing (Amendment) Act 1978 it is amongst other things enacted that the several provisions of this Act shall come into operation on a day or days to be fixed by Proclamation of the Governor in Council published in the Government Gazette.

Now therefore I, the Governor of the State of Victoria in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State do by this my Proclamation fix Thursday, the eighth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and seventy-eight, as the day on which the whole of the said Racing (Amendment) Act 1978 shall come into operation.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria aforesaid, at Melbourne, this Seventh day of June, in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and seventy-eight, and in the twenty-seventh year of the reign of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II.
