APPROVED BREATH ANALYZING INSTRUMENTS

Pursuant to the provisions of sub-section (14) of section 80F of the Motor Car Act 1958, the Lieutenant-Governor as Deputy for His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria, in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, doth hereby approve for the purpose of the said section 80F, of apparatus of the types described hereunder for ascertaining by analysis of a person's breath what percentage of alcohol is present in his blood:—

Types of Apparatus

- 1. Instrument for ascertaining by analysis of a person's breath what percentage of alcohol is present in his blood and bearing thereon (inter alia) the word "breathalyzer" and the expression "U.S. Patent 2,824,789".
- 2. Instrument for ascertaining by analysis of a person's breath what percentage of alcohol is present in his blood and bearing thereon (inter alia) the word "breathalyzer" and the expression "USA Patent No. 2.824.789".

And the Honorable John Frederick Rossiter, Her Majesty's Chief Secretary for the State of Victoria, shall give the necessary directions herein accordingly.
