BROILER CHICKEN INDUSTRY ACT 1978 DATE OF COMING INTO OPERATION

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

Whereas by an Act of Parliament of the State of Victoria passed in the twenty-seventh year of the reign of Her Majesty Elizabeth II., Queen of Australia, entitled the Broiler Chicken Industry Act 1978, it is amongst other things enacted that the provisions of the said Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by Proclamation or successive Proclamations of the Governor in Council published in the Government Gazette.

Now therefore I, the Government of the State of Victoria, in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, do by this my Proclamation fix Tuesday, the twenty-seventh day of November, One thousand nine hundred and seventy-nine, as the date on which the whole of the said Act shall come into operation.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria aforesaid, at Melbourne, this twenty-seventh day of November, in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and seventy-nine, and in the twenty-eighth year of the reign of Her Majesty Elizabeth the Second, Queen of Australia.
