PROCLAMATION

I, the Governor of the State of Victoria, in the Commonwealth of Australia, do hereby declare that I have this day assented, in Her Majesty's name, to the Bills passed by the Parliament of the said State, the titles whereof are hereunder set forth, together with the short titles, that is

No. 9301. "An Act to amend the Business Franchise (Tobacco) Act 1974." (Business Franchise (Tobacco) Act 1979.)

No. 9302. "An Act to increase the Contributions payable by certain Public Authorities under the Public Authorities (Contributions) Act 1966." (Public Authorities (Contributions) Act 1979.)

No. 9303. "An Act to appropriate certain Sums out of the Consolidated Fund for the Service of the Financial Year 1979-80 and to appropriate the Supplies granted in this Session of Parliament and for other purposes." (Appropriation (1979-80, No. 1) Act

Whereas by an Act of Parliament of the State of Victoria passed in the twenty-eighth year of the reign of Her Majesty Elizabeth the Second, by the Grace of God Queen of Australia and Her other Realms and Territories, Head of the Commonwealth, intituled the Workers Compensation (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1979 (No. 9297), it is amongst other things enacted that the said Act shall come into operation on the day or respective days fixed by Proclamation or successive Proclamations of the Government Gazette.

Now therefore I, the Governor of the State of Victoria in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, do by this my Proclamation fix Saturday 1 December 1979, as the day on which all of the provisions of the said Act shall come into operation
