Town and Country Planning Act 1961 CITY OF SOUTH MELBOURNE—HISTORIC BOULEVARDS

Interim Development Order 1980 Notice of Approval

In pursuance of the powers conferred by the Town and Country Planning Act 1961, the Governor in Council on 21 November 1980 approved an Interim Development Order made by the Town and Country Planning Board for part of the municipal district of the City of South Melbourne.

The Interim Development Order provides that the use or development of any land within the area described or the erection, construction or carrying out of any buildings, roads or other works thereon is prohibited except in accordance with the provisions of the Order.

A copy of the Interim Development Order may be inspected, free of charge, at the office of the Council of the City of South Melbourne at South Melbourne, and at the office of the Town and Country Planning Board, 235 Queen Street, Melbourne.
