MOTOR REGISTRATION ACT 1980, No. 9403 Date of Coming into Operation

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

Whereas by an Act of Parliament of the State of Victoria passed in the twenty-ninth year of the reign of Her Majesty Elizabeth II., Queen of Australia, entitled the Motor Registration Act 1980, No. 9403 it is amongst other things enacted that the several provisions of the said Act shall come into operation on a day or the respective days to be fixed by Proclamation or the successive Proclamations of the Government Gazette.

Now, therefore, I, the Governor of the State of Victoria, in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, do by this my Proclamation fix Wednesday, 9 July 1980, as the day on which Sections 1, 4, 6 and 7 of the said Motor Registration Act 1980 No. 9403 shall come into operation.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria aforesaid, at Melbourne, this eighth day of July in the year of our Lord, One thousand nine hundred and eighty and in the twenty-ninth year of the reign of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II.
