## HEALTH ACT 1958

At the Executive Council Chamber, Melbourne, the seventeenth day of February, 1981

Whereas by section 1660 of the Health Act 1958 it is amongst other things enacted that where, in the opinion of the Health Commission of Victoria and the Minister of Health, the Queen's Memorial Infectious Diseases Hospital at Fairfield is ineffectively or incompetently managed, the Governor in Council may, on the recommendation of the Health Commission of Victoria and the Minister of Health by Order published in the Government Gazette appoint a fit and proper person as administrator of the said Hospital; And whereas the Health Commission of Victoria and the

And whereas the Health Commission of Victoria and the Minister of Health have reported that, in their opinion, the Queen's Memorial Infectious Diseases Hospital at Fairfield is inefficiently and incompetently managed and recommended the appointment of a fit and proper person as administrator of the said Hospital;

Now therefore His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, hereby appoints—

Ian Allan George Brand, M.B., B.S., F.H.A., F.R.A.C.M.A., F.S.H.P., F.A.P.H.A., F.R.S.H., A.A.S.A., M.A.C.E., A.I.B.A., M.I.P.M.A., A.B.D.P. (Hon.), as administrator of the Queen's Memorial Infectious Diseases Hospital at Fairfield

And the Honourable William Archibald Borthwick, Her Majesty's Minister of Health for the State of Victoria, shall give the necessary directions herein accordingly.
