CHAIRMAN AND ONE OF THE OTHER
COMMISSIONERS TO BE DEPUTY CHAIRMAN

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria
and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia,
&c., &c., &c.

Whereas it is provided by sub-section (1) of section 3
of the *Local Government (City of Melbourne) Act 1981*,
No. 9525, that the Governor in Council may by Proclama-
tion published in the *Government Gazette* appoint three
persons to be Commissioners of the City of Melbourne
for the purposes of the said Act.

And whereas it is further provided by sub-section (2)
of section 3 of the said Act that the Governor in Council
shall appoint one of the Commissioners to be the Chair-
man and one of the other Commissioners to be Deputy
Chairman.

Now therefore, I, the Governor of the State of Victoria,
by and with the advice of the Executive Council thereof,
do by this Proclamation appoint—

PETER FRANCIS THORLEY

NEIL ANDREW SMITH

DESMOND KENNETH ALLSTON

to be Commissioners of the City of Melbourne for the
purposes of the said Act.

And further, do appoint PETER FRANCIS THORLEY to be
the Chairman and NEIL ANDREW SMITH, to be Deputy
Chairman.
