DATE OF COMING INTO OPERATION

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

Whereas by an Act of Parliament of the State of Victoria passed in the thirty-first year of the reign of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II., entitled the *Film Victoria (Reconstitution) Act 1982*, No. 9808, it is amongst other things enacted that the several provisions of the said Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by Proclamation of the Governor in Council published in the *Government Gazette*.

Now therefore I, the Governor of the State of Victoria in the Commonwealth of Australia by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, do by this my Proclamation fix 21 December 1982 on which the provisions of the *Film Victoria (Reconstitution) Act 1982* shall come into operation.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria, aforesaid at Melbourne, this twenty-first day of December in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and eighty-two, and in the thirty-first year of the reign of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II., Queen of Australia.
