DATE OF COMING INTO OPERATION

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

Whereas by an Act of Parliament of the State of Victoria passed in the thirty-first year of the reign of Her Majesty Elizabeth the Second, Queen of Australia, entitled the *State Electricity Commission (Financial Arrangements) Act 1982, No. 9809*, it is amongst other things enacted that the several provisions of the said Act except section 2 shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by Proclamation of the Governor in Council published in the *Government Gazette*.

Now therefore I, the Governor of the State of Victoria, in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, do by this my Proclamation fix Thursday, 23 December 1982 as the day on which the said *State Electricity Commission (Financial Arrangements) Act 1982, No. 9809*, except section 2 shall come into operation.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria aforesaid, at Melbourne, this twenty-third day of December, in the year of Our Lord One thousand nine hundred and eighty-two, and in the thirty-first year of the reign of Her Majesty Elizabeth the Second, Queen of Australia.
