The co-operation of the general public is sought with a view to establishing the identity of the person or persons responsible for the death of Mrs. Antje Jones who was murdered at No. 98 Theodore Street, St. Albans, on Tuesday, 15 September 1981.

A reward of fifty thousand dollars (\$50 000) will be paid at the discretion of the Chief Commissioner of Police, by the Government of Victoria, for information leading to the apprehension and conviction of the person or persons responsible for this murder.
