## RACING ACT 1958

*At the Executive Council Chamber, Melbourne, the fourth day of May, 1982*

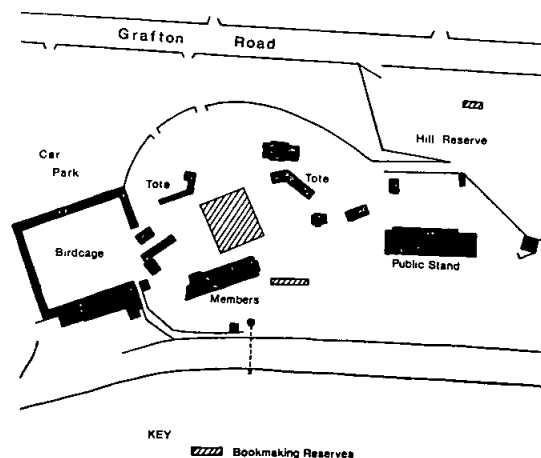

Whereas pursuant to section 5 of the *Racing Act 1958*, regulations made by the Committee of the Warrnambool Racing Club conducting race meetings on the racecourse situated at Warrnambool were approved by the Governor in Council on 24 November 1959 and subsequently amended on 14 September 1971, 15 July 1975, 4 July 1978, 26 June 1979 and 2 June 1981.

And whereas it is provided in the said regulations that no person shall carry on the business or vocation of a bookmaker or a bookmaker's clerk on any part of the said racecourse except such part or parts as may be set aside for that purpose by the Committee and approved by the Governor in Council.

And whereas the plan annexed hereto detailing certain designated bookmaking areas has been submitted by the said Club.

### WARRNAMBOOL RACECOURSE BOOKMAKING RESERVES



Now therefore I the Governor of the State of Victoria, by and with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, do hereby approve the said plan.

And the Honourable Neil Trezise, Her Majesty's Minister for Youth, Sport and Recreation for the State of Victoria, shall give the necessary directions herein accordingly.
