APPOINTMENT OF CERTAIN PERSONS TO BE COMMISSIONERS OF THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND ONE OF THE COMMISSIONERS TO BE THE CHAIRMAN AND ONE TO BE THE DEPUTY CHAIRMAN

Whereas it is provided by sub-section (2) of section 3 of the Local Government (City of Richmond) Act 1982, No. 9744 that the Governor in Council may by Order in Council appoint a person to be a Commissioner or not more than three persons to be Commissioners of the Commission of the City of Richmond.

And whereas it is further provided by sub-section (1) of section 5 of the said Act that where pursuant to section 3 more than one Commissioner is appointed the Governor in Council shall appoint one of the Commissioners to be the Chairman of the Commission and another to be Deputy Chairman of the Commission.

Now therefore, His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria, by and with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, hereby appoint

ALEXANDER GEORGE GILLON, and HOLMAN LINDSAY WILLIAMS to be Commissioners of the Commission of the City of Richmond for the purposes of the said Act.

And further, do appoint Alexander George Gillon to be the Chairman of the Commission and Holman Lindsay Williams to be the Deputy Chairman.

And the Honourable Frank Noel Wilkes, Her Majesty's Minister for Local Government for the State of Victoria, shall give the necessary directions herein accordingly.

Local Government (City of Richmond) Act 1982, No. 9744 FIXING OF THE "APPOINTED DAY"

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

Whereas it is provided by sub-section (1) of section 2 of the Local Government (City of Richmond) Act 1982 No. 9744 that the "Appointed Day" means the day fixed by Proclamation of the Governor in Council published in the Government Gazette for the purposes of section 7.

And whereas it is provided by section 7 of the said Act that the matters referred to therein shall take effect on the appointed day.

Now therefore, I, the Governor of the State of Victoria, by and with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, do by this Proclamation fix Thursday 8 July 1982 as the "Appointed Day" for the purposes of section 7 of the Act.
