DATE OF COMING INTO OPERATION

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

Whereas by an Act of Parliament of the State of Victoria passed in the thirty-first year of the reign of Her Majesty Elizabeth the Second, Queen of Australia, entitled the Abattoir and Meat Inspection (Amendment) Act 1982 No. 9757 it is amongst other things enacted that the several provisions of the said Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation of the Government Gazette:

Now therefore, I, the Governor of the State of Victoria, in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, do by this my Proclamation fix Wednesday 28 July 1982, as the day on which the provisions of the said Abattoir and Meat Inspection (Amendment) Act 1982 No. 9757 shall come into operation.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria aforesaid at Melbourne, this twenty-eighth day of July in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and eighty-two, and in the thirty-first year of the reign of Her Majesty Elizabeth the Second, Queen of Australia.
