Fuel Prices Regulation Act 1981
ORDER FIXING AND DECLARING THE MAXIMUM PRICE OF DECLARED FUELS UNDER SECTION 7

Whereas by notice dated 30 July and published in the Government Gazette on 4 August 1982 the Minister declared—

(a) the whole of Victoria to be a proclaimed area; and

(b) certain kinds of fuel to be declared fuels—for the purposes of the Fuel Prices Regulation Act 1981 with effect as from 4 August 1982.

And whereas, pursuant to section 7 of the said Act, the Prices Commissioner may, with respect to any declared fuel, from time to time by Order published in the Government Gazette fix and declare the maximum price at which any such fuel may be sold generally or in any part of the State or in any proclaimed area.

Now therefore, I, Donald Spencer Jones, Acting Prices Commissioner, do hereby fix and declare maximum retail and wholesale prices inclusive of taxes as set out below with effect as from the date of publication of the Government Gazette in which this Order appears.

For the whole of the free delivery area which includes the Melbourne and Geelong Metropolitan areas (but excludes the Portland free delivery area) and the City of Frankston and the Shire of Healesville and Lillydale.

Maximum retail price: motor spirit 97 RON 43.9 motor spirit 89 RON 42.9

Maximum bulk wholesale price to resellers: motor spirit 97 RON 39 9 motor spirit 89 RON 38 9

For areas which are outside the free delivery area, but are included in the above areas, the same prices as for the free delivery area apply, plus an amount equivalent to the amount (if any) that at the time the sale is made is the freight differential approved by the Petroleum Products Pricing Authority in respect of the area where the motor spirit is delivered, less any subsidy payable under the States Grants (Petroleum Products) Act 1965.
